

# I TRA-SC QUICK INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS



Complete installation instructions for I TRA-SC (Self Contained) can be found on the I TRA-SC Install CD.

## Targeted Environment

---

- Windows 7, 8.1, or 10 and either 32 or 64 Bit (**User MUST have Administrator privileges**)
- USB port
- Token

If more information on environments is needed see I TRA-SC (Self Contained) Desktop Installation document.

## I TRA-SC Setup

---

1. On Windows 7 or later right click the setup executable located on the I TRA-SC Setup Install CD, and select "Run as Administrator."
2. **Welcome Screen:** Click Next to begin the I TRA-SC installation. If you already have I TRA-SC installed, you will be allowed to modify, repair or remove the installation. Please see the Desktop Installation document for more information on these features.
3. **Choose Location for Installation:** The user may choose a location for the installation. Click "Next" to continue the installation process.
4. **Confirm Proxy Settings:** The user may review and either edit or disable proxy settings that will be set for the I TRA-SC. Click "Next" to continue the installation process.
5. **Ready to Install:** I TRA-SC is now ready to be installed. Click "Install" to install I TRA-SC. The screen will display the status of the installation.
6. **Finished:** I TRA-SC is now successfully installed. Click "Finish" to exit the installer.

## Verify access to the I TRA application

---

Click **Start -> All Programs -> I TRA -> I TRA – Self Contained (I TRA-SC) -> Launch I TRA Self Contained**, or double-click on the Desktop shortcut and continue to I TRA selection of the actions:.



### Medium Assurance certificate generation (SPS & ITS.gov):

1. TRA will insert his/her iKey USB token into the workstation and click the TRA Assisted Create/Recovery button.
2. TRA will be prompted to acknowledge U.S. Government privacy "Warning Message", after which TRA will enter his/her password.
3. If the login attempt was successful, the I TRA-SC installation is complete. Exit I TRA.

### Rudimentary Assurance certificate generation (TCIS & Debt Check):

1. The user may select the Self Service Create/Recovery button. If after user's acknowledgement of U.S. Government privacy "Warning Message", the "Self Service Create/Recover PKI Credential" screen appears, the I TRA installation is complete. Exit I TRA.
